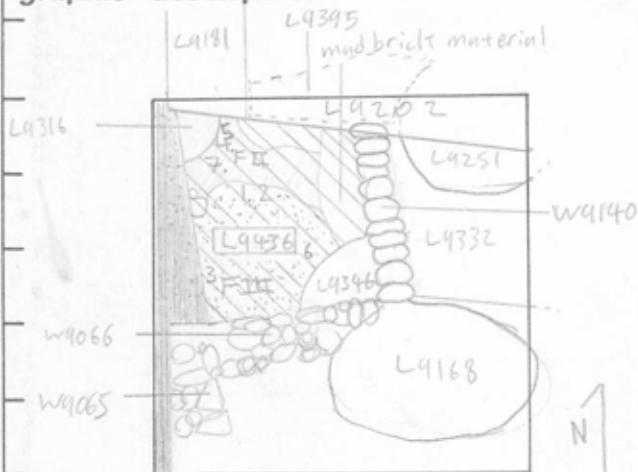

Summary:

Description:

Opened: when L9346 was discovered below L9328 at end of '88 season. The rest of L9328 was not named L9436 until '89 season.

Definition/Limits: defined by L9316 and L9202 to the North, W9140 to the East, L9346 and W9066 to the South, and half to W.

Matrix mudbrick material w/ large amounts of fallen reed mat material, some bones, several in situ vessels and many pottery sherds, w/ some bone. Floor I is very patchy bits of a dull reed matting material. Floor II is the same dull matting and covers 1/2 of the locus. Floor III is a grey ash, make up w/ bits of charcoal in it. Reed mat material is probably fall from a wall matrix (see W9275) or could be coiling material.

Reason for closing: not closed end of '89 season. Locus has been completely excavated however and should get a new number in '91 for make-up and material below F9436 and for the mudbrick material West of W9140.

Relationship to Other Elements: L9436 reaches W9066, W9140, L9346 cuts the fill of L9436. L9436 also reaches the rubble material of L9202 and L9395, L9436
