IS CUT BY BOTH ROBBER TRENCHES [L9392] IN THE SOUTH & [L9435] TO THE WEST. THIS RUBBLE COULD POSSIBLY HAVE BEEN A WALL THAT WAS DISTURBED WHEN THE ROBBER TRENCHES WERE DUG OR MAY HAVE BEEN USED AS BACKFILL FOR THE TRENCHES. [L9438] IS DEFINITELY A DISTURBED LOCUS.
