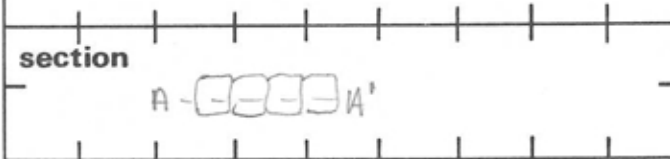
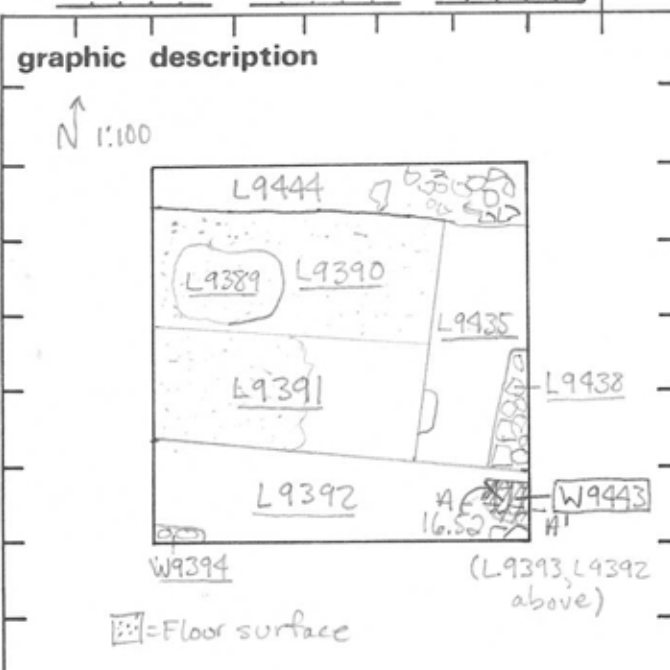

Description: REASON FOR OPENING: CAME DOWN ON THREE STONES IN A LINE WHILE DIGGING L9393 / L9392.

DEF./LIMITS: W9443 REACHES THE EAST BAULK. TO THE NORTH, SOUTH, AND WEST IT IS SURROUNDED BY L9392.

MATRIX: W9443 IS MADE UP OF FOUR ASHLARS LAID IN A HEADER WALL CONSTRUCTION.

REASON FOR CLOSING: END OF SEASON - not closed

RELATIONS: W9443 IS PARTIALLY BELOW L9393 (PIT) AND THE ROBBER TRENCH FILL OF L9392. ONLY FURTHER EXCAVATION CAN REVEAL ANY LOCI BELOW W9443. THOUGH W9443, WHICH RUNS EAST/WEST IS CUT BY

ROBBER TRENCH L9392 IT MAY HAVE EXTENDED FURTHER TO THE WEST AND BEEN PART OF THE CONSTRUCTION THAT WAS ROBBED OUT IN L9392. W9443 HEADER STONES ARE ALL APPROXIMATELY 14 cm x 40 cm (HEIGHT NOT YET DETERMINED SINCE BOTTOM OF WALL HAS NOT BEEN REACHED. THOUGH W9443 IS ONLY 20 cm SOUTH OF THE RUBBLE AND POSSIBLE WALL OF L9438 THEY ARE NOT OF SIMILAR CONSTRUCTION METHODS. HOWEVER THEY BOTH MAY HAVE BEEN DISTURBED AT THE SAME TIME (WHEN RT L9438 OR RT L9392 WAS BEING DUG
