Summary:

Description: REASON FOR OPENING: L9448 SPLIT INTO L9451 AND L9452.  
L9451 IS A CONTINUATION OF L9448.

DEF./LIMITS: BOUNDED ON THE N BY L9511 AND L9484, ON THE W BY L9453, ON THE S BY THE BULK, ON THE E BY THE BULK AND W9345.

MATRIX: GRAY-BROWN SANDY SOIL WITH FEWER SHEARDS, MANY KURKAR CHUNKS.

REASON FOR CLOSING: CAME DOWN ON L9512, RED-BROWN, COMPACT SOIL.

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: L9451 may be the remains of a N-S robber trench for W9510 which extends N. into AK34. If so, it may cut L9453 which seems to be a Persian Pit. In its turn L9451 is cut by

L9511, apparently a robber trench for W9013 (the "blob"), discovered in AJ33. Relations to W9345 are uncertain.

L9451 REACHES L9484. A LOCUS OF THE SAME MATERIAL AS L9512. L9484 WAS COLLAPSED INTO L9512.

RT cuts W9015 but is cut by W9003 & sealed by F9232. Therefore it is phase 1b.
