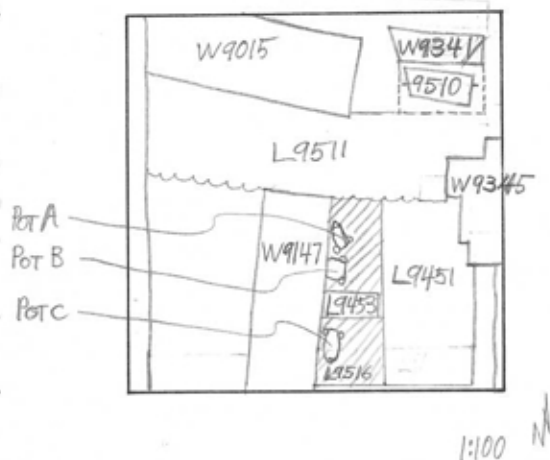

DEF./LIMITS: BOUNDED ON THE N BY [L9511], ON THE W BY [W9147], ON THE E BY [L9451] AND ON THE S BY THE BULK.

MATRIX: GRAY-YELLOW SOIL, MOSTLY SAND, MANY SHEARDS, FEW SHELLS, SOME FIST SIZE KURKAR RUBBLE, A FEW CHARCOAL AND MUDBRICK DEBRIS BITS.

REASON FOR CLOSING: CAME DOWN ON [L9516], YELLOW, MOIST, SANDY SOIL.

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: [L9453] IS APPARENTLY A PERSIAN PIT. IT IS CUT BY [W9147], AN EARLY HELLENISTIC CONSTRUCTION; BY [L9511], AN APPARENT ROBBER TRENCH FOR [W9003]; AND BY [L9451], AN APPARENT ROBBER TRENCH FOR [W9510].
