

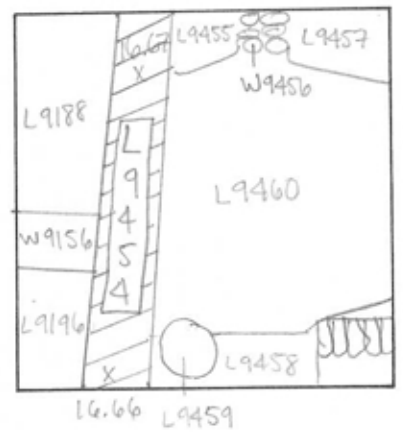

Summary:

Description: REASON FOR OPENING: CAME DOWN ON DARK BROWN/BLACK SOIL UNDER BOTTOM COURSE OF W9147

DEF./LIMITS: L9454 EXTENDS TO THE NORTH & SOUTH Baulks. TO THE EAST IT REACHES L9460 & L9455. LOCI TO WEST NOT YET DETERMINED.

MATRIX: DARK BLACK/BROWN SOIL WITH LITTLE POTTERY OR ROCKS

REASON FOR CLOSING: LOCUS NOT CLOSED BECAUSE WEST SIDE OF W9147 WAS NOT EXCAVATED THIS SEASON. HOWEVER, THE END OF THE F.T. CAN BE SEEN IN THE BAULK UNDER THE WALL on the eastern side.

RELATIONS: L9454 IS DIRECTLY BELOW W9147 AND IS THE FOUNDATION TRENCH FOR THIS WALL. IT PROBABLY CONTINUES TO THE NORTH UNDER

THE WALL INTO SQUARES AK33 & AK34. L9454 REACHES L9460 & L9455 AND MAY CUT INTO THESE PITS IF W9147 IS A LATER CONSTRUCTION. RELATIONS TO THE WEST ARE UNKNOWN SINCE THIS PART OF SQUARE AK32 WAS NOT EXCAVATED. ALSO LOCI BELOW ARE UNKNOWN SINCE W9147 HAS NOT BEEN REMOVED.

In 1987 it was thought that 9174 (and 9189) might be FT material; if so they would be contemporary with 9454 (JZ'91)
