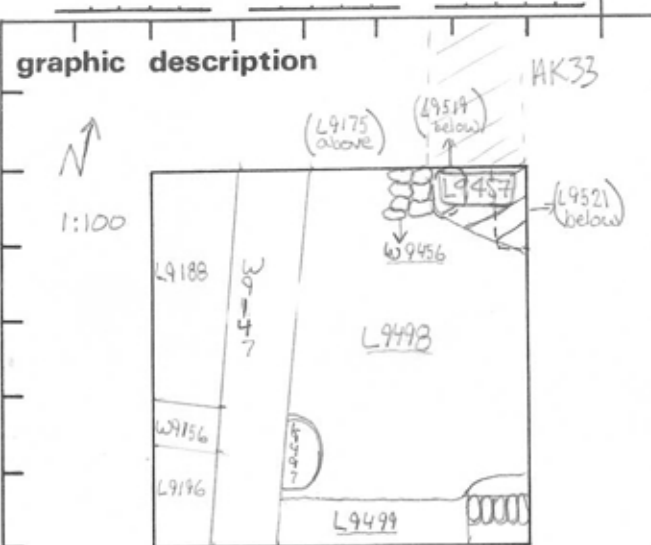

Description: REASON FOR OPENING: AFTER SQUARE CLEANING CAME DOWN ON PATCH OF HARD RED CLAY LIKE SOIL IN NE CORNER.

DEF / LIMITS: L9457 REACHES W9456 IN THE WEST. IT BORDERS THE NORTH & EAST Baulks. IN THE SOUTH IT IS SUCCESSIVELY BORDERED BY L9460, L9479, L9480, L9481 & L9498 WHICH ARE ALL PART OF A LARGE PERSIAN PIT.

MATRIX: HARD RED SOIL WITH CHUNKS OF CLAY LIKE MATERIAL, CHARCOAL, ROCKS & POTTERY

REASON FOR CLOSING: CAME DOWN ON MUDBRICK & REED MAT MATERIAL IN EAST & SHELL PIT IN WEST.

RELATIONS: L9457 IS DIRECTLY BELOW L9175 WHICH WAS NO LONGER VISIBLE AFTER TWO YEARS OF EROSION. L9457 IS DIRECTLY ABOVE L9519 A SHELL PIT. L9521 A POSSIBLE MUDBRICK & REED MAT WALL. RELATIONS BETWEEN W9456 & L9457 ARE UNCERTAIN. L9457 IS CUT BY THE LARGE PERSIAN PIT WHICH INCLUDES LOCI L9460, L9479, L9480, L9481 & L9498. FURTHERMORE L9457 MAY EXTEND TO THE NORTH INTO SQUARE AK33 (L9512), WHICH MAY BE PART OF A ROBBER TRENCH FOR W9510 - RUNNING IN LINE
