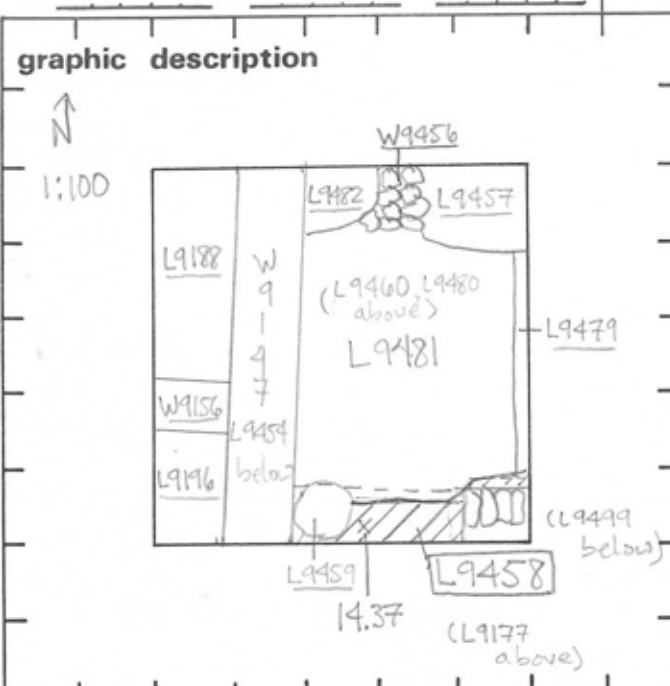

Description: REASON FOR OPENING: CAME DOWN ON VERY HARD, MOIST ORANGE BROWN SOIL AFTER CLEANING.

DEF/LIMITS: L9458 EXTENDS TO THE SOUTH & EAST BAULKS. TO THE WEST IT REACHES L9459 AND IN THE NORTH IT IS BORDERED BY L9481 & L9479

MATRIX: ORANGE/BROWN SOIL WITH LITTLE POTTERY, BONE, OR SHELLS.

REASON FOR CLOSING: CAME DOWN ON BROWN SOIL THAT WAS EXTENDING THROUGH MOST OF THE SQUARE & REACHED BOTTOM OF PIT L9459

RELATIONS: L9458 IS DIRECTLY BELOW L9177 WHICH WAS NO LONGER VISIBLE AFTER EROSION & SQUARE CLEANING. L9458 IS DIRECTLY ABOVE L9499 WHICH APPEARS TO BE THE SAME FILL BUT WAS GIVEN A NEW NUMBER WHEN BOTTOM OF PIT L9459 WAS FOUND. L9458

IS CUT BY THIS LATER PIT L9459. L9458 BORDERS THE LARGE PERSIAN PIT IN THE NORTH AND SEEM TO BE CUT BY ALL FOUR OF THIS PIT'S LOCI (L9460, L9480, L9479, & L9481). ALSO THOUGH L9458 DISAPPEARS UNDER THE SE BAULK, IT LIKELY EXTENDS UNDER THIS PEDASTLE. L9458 MAY BE THE ORIGINAL SOIL INTO WHICH THESE PITS & W9147 WERE CUT.

7/02 ED 5 matrix is mudbrick material (Ph 6) but clearly mixed w/ Ph 5 pottery.
