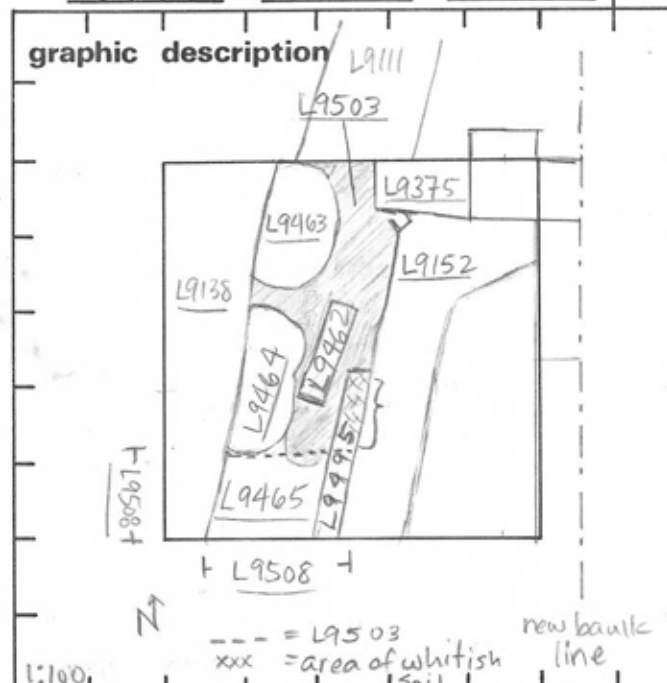

Summary:

Description:

Open: In excavating fill [L9450] came down on 4 distinct areas of different soil color, each made into a separate locus ([L9462], [L9463], [L9464], [L9465])

Def & Limits: To W bordered by [L9138], [L9463] & [L9464] To N bordered by material below [L9111]. To E bordered by [L9375], [L9152], [L9495], to S bordered by [L9465].

Matrix: Thick, hard whitish soil, with numerous pot sherds (very worn) near surface. Just below surface, soil grey-white, loosely packed, with few sherds.

Closing: Came down upon uniformly hard surface^{in [L9462]} that could be floor / surface that extends into N half of [L9495], so both loci closed, and collapsed into [L9503]

Relations: To W, probably cut by pits [L9463] & [L9464]; may be the same as fill [L9138], although Locus card does not mention whitish soil, or perhaps [L9462] cut by [L9138]. To N, material of [L9462] seems to extend to N below drain [L9111]. Lies below [L9375] and material below [L9375]. [L9462] is perhaps cut by [L9152] or might contain some material - impossible
