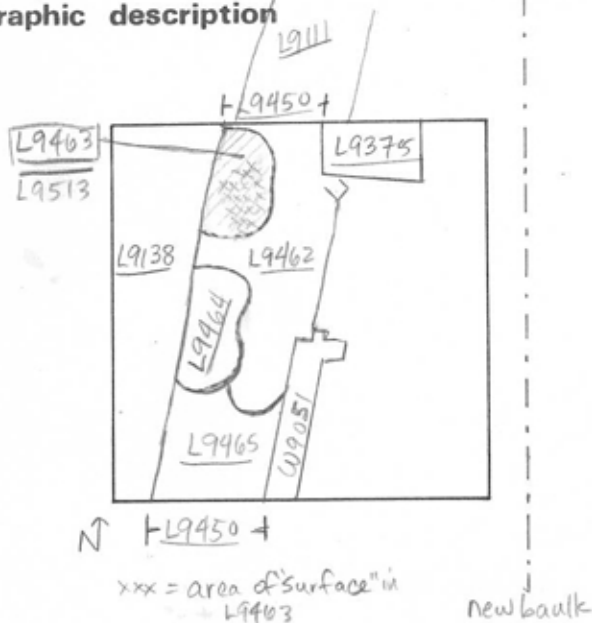

Summary:

Description:

Open: In excavating fill L9450, came down on 4 distinct areas of differently colored soil, each made into a separate locus L9462, L9463, L9464, and L9465

Def & Limits: To W, bounded by L9138. To N, bordered by material below drain L9111 in Square AI33. To E & S, bordered by L9462 and material below.

Matrix: Sandy, grey soil, mixed with ash, bits of plaster, & kurkar debris. Lots of bones & pot sherds including heavy storage jars. Ca. 20 cm down came upon uniformly hard white surface (possible floor?)

Closing: Came down "floor"-like surface across pit, which extended toward S & SE into adjacent loci.

Relations: Probably cuts L9462. The relationship to L9138 to W is unclear. L9463 was covered by L9450 completely. It was very difficult to isolate & define the limits of pit L9463 from the locus of fill L9462 that it cuts. As continued to excavate
