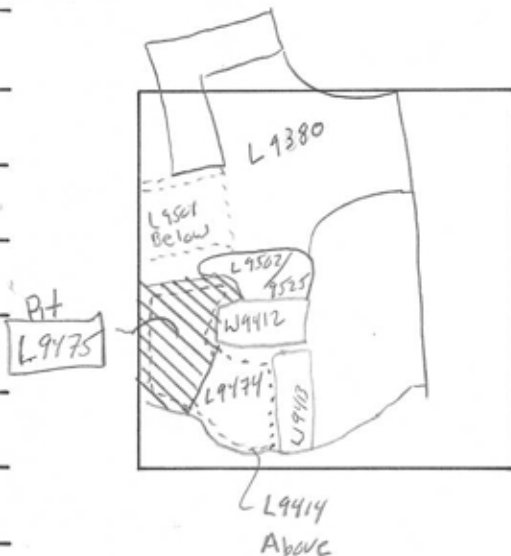

Summary:

Description: Opened: As pit L9414 (et al) narrowed to the E. burnt layer, L9474 was revealed in the SE portion of pit L9414; the pit continues down as L9475.

Def/lim: North By sloping surfaces L9380, 9501, 9502, 9525, East By sloping surfaces L9502, L9525 and W9412 and L9474. South and west By Bank.

Matrix: Sandy Brown Soil with Many Shards and Bones.

closed: end of season; not closed.

Relations: Cuts sloping surfaces, wall 9412 and L9474. Same pit as L9414/L9378, et al, above.

Sloping surfaces are a series of about 15 floor resurfacings. They reach the north face of W9412, and continue

under W9140 and W9065-66, and W9400. They are the earliest phase in the west of W9140
