Description: REASON FOR OPENING: CAME DOWN ON ASH; CHARCOAL EXTENDING SLIGHTLY OUT OF EAST BAULK

DEF./LIMITS: [L9479] BORDERS [L9457] IN THE NORTH, [L9481]; [L9480] IN THE WEST; [L9458] IN THE SOUTH. IT EXTENDS TO THE EAST BAULK AND MAY HAVE CONTINUED IN SQUARE AJ32.

MATRIX: LIGHT GREY ASH WITH LOTS OF CHARCOAL AND SOME POTTERY, BONES, & BRONZE.

REASON FOR CLOSING: ASH LAYER ENDED; MATRIX BECAME SAME AS THAT OF [L9481]. COLLAPSED INTO ONE NEW LOCUS. (L9498)

RELATIONS: [L9479] IS DIRECTLY BELOW [L9460], THE PERSIAN PIT. IT IS

DIRECTLY ABOVE [L9498] WHICH IS PART OF THIS SAME PIT. THIS MAY SUGGEST THAT [L9479] IS JUST AN ASH LENSE WITHIN THIS PIT. HOWEVER, [L9479] CUTS BOTH [L9480] AND [L9481] WHICH ARE ALSO PART OF THE PERSIAN PIT. SINCE THIS IS SO, [L9479] COULD BE A LATER PIT DUG INTO THESE LOCI OR USED CONCURRENTLY WITH THEM BUT CLOSED BEFORE THE LATEST DEPOSITIONAL LAYER (L9460) WAS ADDED TO THE BIG PERSIAN PIT. [L9479] ALSO CUTS [L9457]; [L9458] WHICH SUPPORTS ITS INCLUSION IN THE LARGE PERSIAN PIT SINCE IT CUTS OVER →

7/02 EBS - L9479 = AJ32, L9128 OR L9112 a single ash layer
 (against the bulk) at a high elevation (w. so. AK32) and
 2 ash splays at lower elevation in AJ32, so, the AK splay
 may belong with either or both of the splays in AJ.
