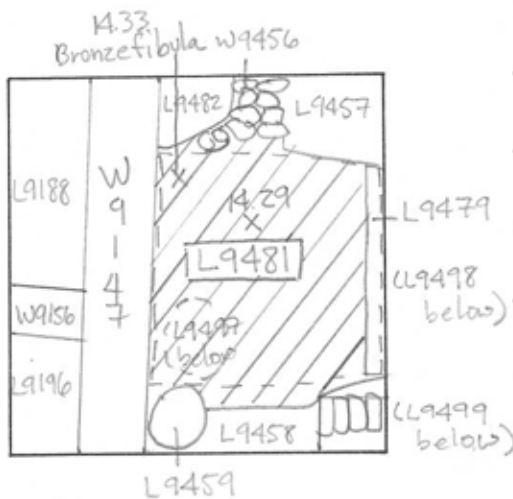

PART OF THE SAME PERSIAN PIT. IT IS DIRECTLY ABOVE THE CHARCOAL PIT L9497 AND L9498 THE CONTINUATION OF THE PERSIAN PIT. L9481 CUTS BOTH THE FILLS OF L9482; L9457 AS WELL AS W9456. SINCE ALL THREE LOCI ARE CUT ALONG THE SAME E/W LINE THEY MAY ALL BE EARLIER THAN THIS PIT. L9481 IS CUT BY ASH LENSE L9499 THO THEY MAY BE PART OF SAME PIT. L9481 CUTS FILL L9458 BUT IT IS PARTIALLY CUT BY PIT L9459 IF L9479 CUTS L9481 IT IS A DISTURBED LOCUS
