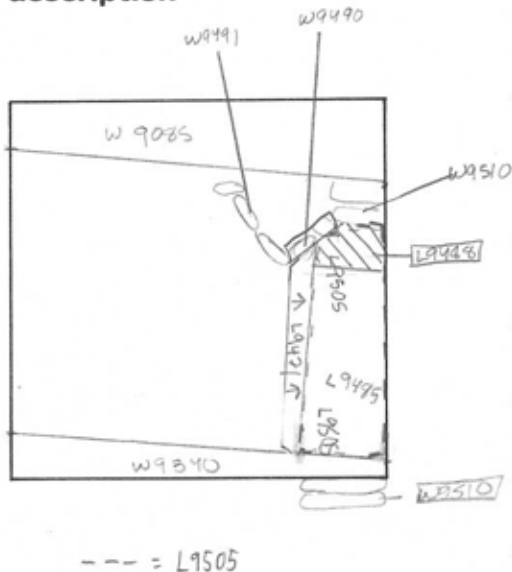

REASON FOR OPENING: ROCK PILE DISAPPEARED FROM N. END OF [L9471].

MATRIX: LIGHT ORANGE CLUMPY SOIL. FEW ROCKS.

DEFINITION/LIMITS: BOUNDED ON E. BY BAULK, ON W BY [W9490], ON S. BY [L9485], ON N BY LARGE ASHLER BLOCK WHICH WAS LATER REVEALED TO BE PART OF [W9510] (TOP COURSE SURVIVING).

REASON FOR CLOSING: CAME DOWN ON ORANGE SOIL MIXED WITH MUDBRICK MATERIAL (CONTAINING FEW ROCKS) UNDER [L9486] AND PART OF [L9485] COLLAPSED [L9486] AND [L9485] INTO [L9505].

RELATIONS COVERED BY ROCK PILE [L9471]. ^{Probably reaches} [L9485]*. May rob

[W9510] CUT BY [W9490]. COVERS [L9505]. MAY BE PART OF RT. OF [W9510].

[L9486] + [L9485] might be contemporary but different backfills of a robber trench of [W9510].
