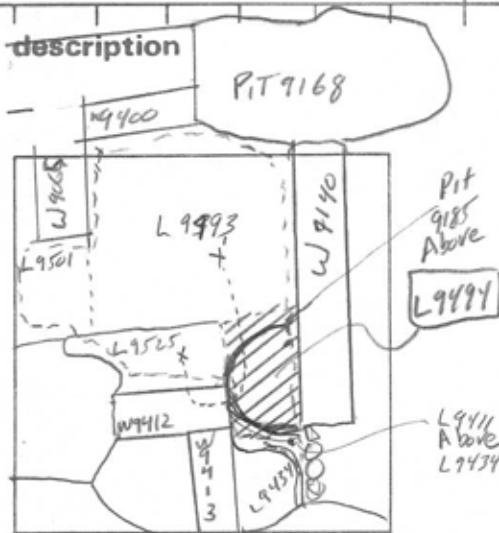

Summary:

Description: Opened: When Ash Pit [L9185] came down onto sloping surfaces [L9494] created from below [L9380] and [L9185].

Def/Lim: North by [L9493], West by [L9525 and below], south by [L9434], East by [W9140].

Matrix: Grey/Brown Ashy Soil on Ash Plaster Floor.

Closed: When Floor [L9494] defined.

Relations: [L9494] is part of the sloping surfaces\*. It appears to slope beneath [W9412], which would make this floor earlier than those above it which reach the north face of [W9412]. It seems to continue under [W9140] and may continue under [L9434] in south. The

Floor of [L9493] may be the same surface as [L9494]. N9420<sup>UP</sup> floats well above [L9494], may dive below [W9413]. 9111

\*The sloping surfaces consist of [L9380, 9411, 9493, 9494, 9501, 9502, and L9525]. They are the earliest phase west of [W9140]. Upper surfaces reach [W9412]. They consist of about 15 floor resurfacings.
