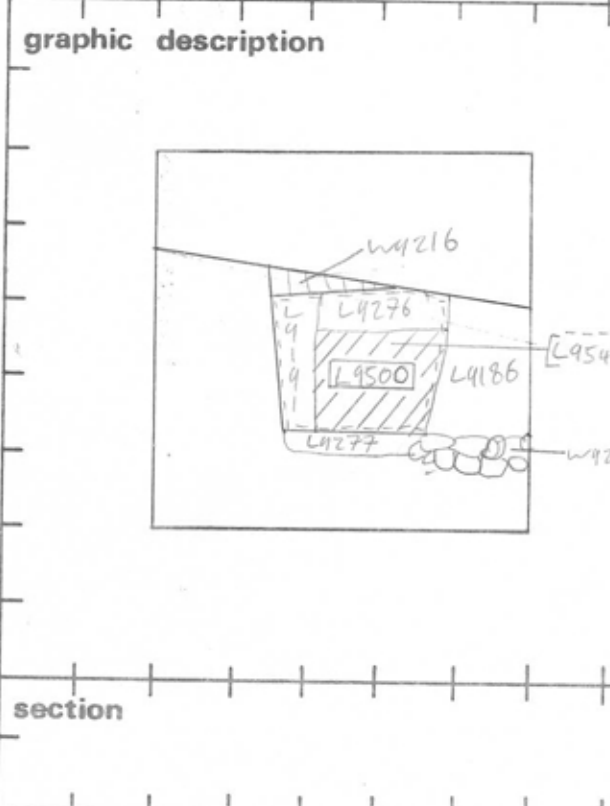

Summary:

Description: Reason for Opening: F9179 was removed and material beneath named L9500.

Definition/Limits: bounded by L9276 to the North, L9186 to the East, L9277 to the South, and L9191 to the West.

Matrix: hard packed brown soil/mudbrick material with many bones, pottery sherds, and small fieldstones.

Reason for Closing: collapsed w/ L9191 & L9276 when all three were determined to be of the same depositional unit.

Relationships to Other Elements: L9500 is sealed by F9179.

It is cut by ^{Pit} L9186, and reached by L9191, L9276, and L9277, which are all three of the same depositional unit. L9500 covers the center of L9548, which is also of the same depositional unit.
