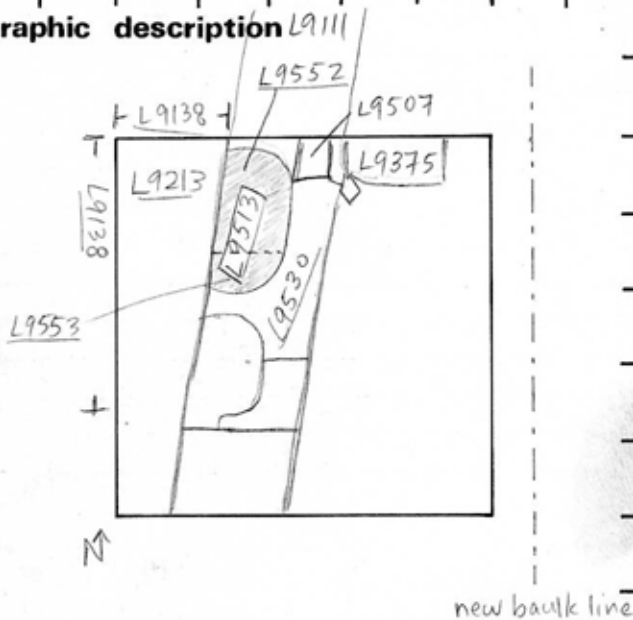

Summary:

Description:

Open: In excavating pit [L9463] came down on floor-like "surface" that extended S & SE into adjacent loci. But could see from section in Western bank of pedestal that pit continued down further than this "surface", so opened to excavate below "surface"

Def. & Limits: To N, bordered by material below drain L9111 in Square AI33. To E and S, bounded by [L9507] and material below. To W, bounded by [L9138] and material below.

Matrix: As in pit [L9463] sandy-grey earth, mixed with charcoal, and layers of harder, white material visible in section and while taking down pit, probably

indicating different deposits within same pit over time. Elevations taken of these hard white "layers," noted below.

Closing: Came down on mudbrick debris at S end of [L9513], so divided pit into two loci [L9552] & [L9553]

Relations: To E & S, cuts [L9530], although part of [L9530] immediately S of [L9513]
