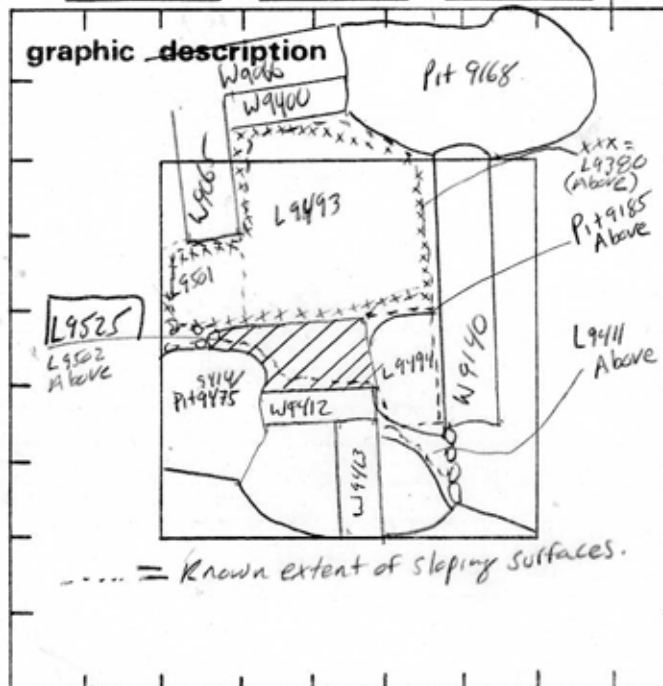

Summary:

Description: Opened 7: After removing Rubble and defining Floor L9502, L9525 was opened to excavate sloping surfaces*.

Def/Lim 7: North By L9380/9493, East By Pit L9185, South By W9412, West By Pit 9117 and Rubble.

Matrix 7: Multiple Ash Plaster and Ash Floors, separated by Light gray Ashy Soil, and Sheds.

Closed 7: When pedestal lowered to level of L9501 and L9493.

Relations 7: Floors V and IX clearly reach W9412. Cut by Pit 9185 and Pit 9117. Reached by L9380/9493. This locus is a part of the sloping surfaces. There

Are 9 clear surfaces within this locus (Levels + descriptions on back). *The sloping surfaces are constituted by L9380, 9411, 9494, 9493, 9501, 9502 and 9525. They are the earliest phase west of wall 9140. The surface of L9497 slopes under W9412. There are still several surfaces in section of L9525 below surface IX and above E9494 whose relations to wall 9412 are not yet clear. L9494 probably represents →

Relations cont'd 7: an earlier phase of the sloping surfaces before the construction of [W9412/13]. Though they are parts of a single series of surfaces, a direct 1:1 correlation of surfaces in L9525 to those in other "sloping surface" loci is not possible (due to excavation methods).
