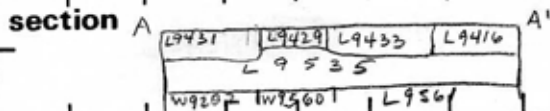

Description: OPENED: UPON DEFINING AREA EAST OF (L9431) AS CONTINUATION OF ROBBER TRENCH OVER (W9282)

DEFINITION/LIMITS: BOUNDED BY WEST, SOUTH AND EAST BAWLKS BOUNDED BY (L9432) TO THE SOUTH; (W9515), (L9514), (L9542), (L9546), (L9388) TO THE NORTH

CLOSED: UPON REACHING (W9560) AND (W9282)

MATRIX: MEDIUM-PACKED GREY BROWN SOIL WITH MANY LARGE ROCKS, SHELS, ROOFTILE FRAGMENTS

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: CUTS (L9478), ROBBER TRENCH OVER (W9515); CUTS (L9542), (L9546), FILLS OF ROBBER TRENCH OVER (W9545) CUTS (L9514), (L9388). Part of system of at least 3 robber trenches which rob out walls of a Roman period basement. (W9560) and (W9282) are of different periods and on different alignment.
