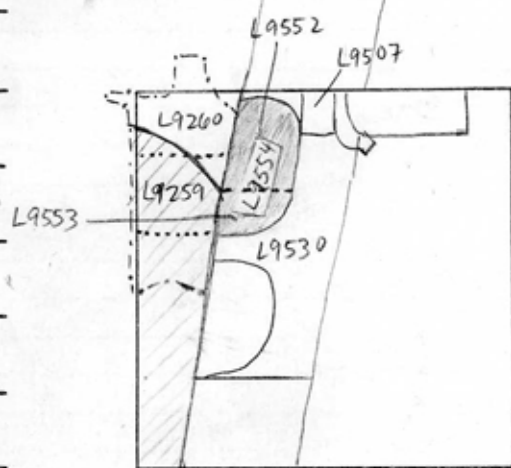

Description:

Opening: Pit [L9552] reached bottom & came down upon MB material like that in [L9553] to S, so collapsed both into one locus

Def & Limits: To N, bordered by material below [L9111] To E bordered by [L9507]. To E & S, bordered by [L9530]. To W, bordered by [L9259] & [L9260]

Matrix: Hard-packed, dark brown mudbrick material, mixed with charcoal & some pottery coming down to one or more floors or resurfacing of floors. All this is mudbrick collapse debris

Closing: End of Season - Not fully excavated, not closed

Relations: [L9554] lies below [L9552] and [L9553].

Material of [L9554] identical to that of [L9259], and so [L9554] may reach [L9259] to W. The relationship between [L9554] & [L9260] is a bit unclear. [L9260] is a pit, with sandy, grey soil & many shell & sherds. The material above the N half of [L9554] was also a pit ([L9552]) with identical matrix as [L9260]. Pit [L9260] reached its bottom at elevation 13.89 m. Below [L9260] & [L9259] is [L9296], accumulation on floor. In the
