L9819 IS A SUMMER STORAGE BIN IN AG33 WHICH APPEARS TO USE SOME STONES OF W9560 ALONG ITS SOUTHERN FACE, TO FORM THE NORTHERN SECTION OF ITS STONE CIRCLE, BUT NONE OF THE STONES INTERLOCK. EITHER THEY ARE OF CONTEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION, OR L9819 IS OF A LATER BUILDING PHASE. 2-3 COURSES OF W9560 ARE VISIBLE ALONG ITS S. FACE.

THE EASTERN SECTION OF W9560 WAS DISCOVERED IN THE NORTHERN BALK OF AG33, WITH 2 STONES ENTERING AG33 AT THE EAST BALK. L9796 AND L9757 CONTINUE NORTH INTO AG34 WHERE THEY ARE CUT BY W9560, A FOUNDATION.

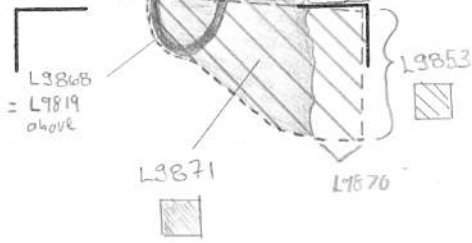
