At present it is assumed that the area between W9515 and W9545, L9514, is a continuation of the Roman basement to the W. If this is true, a continuation of W9282 further E is expected, and on about the same line. It is possible that such an extension existed over W9560 + L9561 but was robbed out by L9535 (et al above), a distinct robber trench.
