Matrix: CONSISTS OF A LINING OF BROKEN POT SHEEPS AT LEAST 3 PIECES THICK WITH A INNER RING OF BAKED-YELLOWISH CLAY MATERIAL. HOLLOW INTERIOR CONSISTS OF CLAY, POT SHEEPS AND ASH/CHARCOAL MATERIAL.

Relations: L9658 IS COVERED BY L9630; REACHES L9210 TO THE WEST AND L9657 REACHES L9658 ON THE NORTH, EAST AND SOUTH. L9658 COMES DOWN ON AND POSSIBLY CUTS FLOOR OF L9657

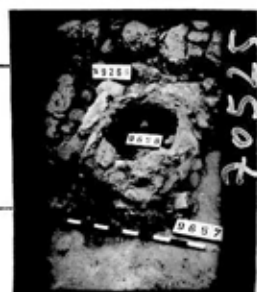
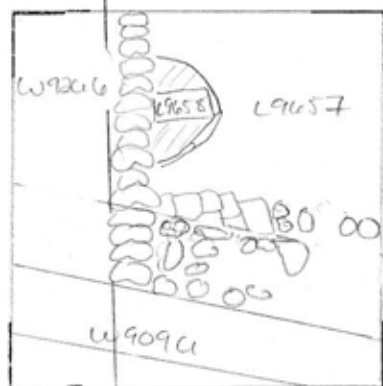

Closed: WHEN ALL TABUN MATERIAL HAD BEEN REMOVED AND THE INTERIOR WAS EXCAVATED BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE FLOOR (F9657)

Matrix: INTERIOR WAS VERY ASHY, IT GREY SOFT MATERIAL, COMPLETELY UNLIKE THE MATERIAL USED TO RE-FILL THE TABUN OVER PLASTIC AT THE END OF THE 91 SEASON. THE TABUN SOIL WAS CLEAN OF CONTAMINATION. HIGH CONCENTRATION OF POTTERY SHEERDS LINED THE INSIDE & OUTSIDE OF THE TABUN SHELL. SOIL CONTAINED SOME SHEERDS, FLICKS OF CHARCOAL, A FEW SEA SHELLS AND ONE PIECE OF BONE.

Relations: L9658 COVERS BUT DOESN'T SEAL L9898. IT IS COVERED BUT NOT SEALED BY L9630. IT IS REACHED BY CLEANING LOCUS L9856 ON THE NORTH, SOUTH, AND EAST, AS WELL AS L9657 AGAIN ON THE NORTH, SOUTH, AND EAST TO THE WEST IT IS REACHED BY A TWILIGHT ZONE IN BETWEEN THE TABUN AND W9266 - IT DOES NOT REACH W9266 AS STATED IN 1991 CARD FOR THIS LOCUS. THE TABUN IS DUG FROM F9657. TABUN L9880 IS ALSO DUG FROM THE FLOOR AND IS AT THE SAME APPROX ELEVATION, BUT IT IS UNCLEAR WHETHER THE TWO TABUNS WERE USED AT THE SAME TIME, OR IF TABUN L9658 WAS BUILT AFTER TABUN L9880.
