<b>Summary</b>				

**Opened:** When L9644 was removed and pitty material beneath named L9655 and fallen mud-brick material cut by L9655 collapsed with similar material beneath L9645 to form L9662

**Limits (N)** Bounded on the North by similar unexcavated material beneath L9604 and W9510.

**(S)** Bounded on the South by cleaning locus L9603.

**(E)** Bounded on the East by pit L9655.

**(W)** Bounded on the West by L9663.

**Closed:** When locus was collapsed with similar material beneath L9603 and L9655, as well as the material of L9663 to form L9679. Material below L9603 is L9668 and L9669.

**Matrix:** fallen brown mudbrick material with small Karkar chunks, some pottery, and fallen wall plaster.

**Relations:** L9662 is partially covered by foundation trench L9644, which also cuts the material of L9662, and by L9645, which may cut the material of L9662 if L9645 is the continuation of L9511 (see card for L9645) but most likely L9662 is the continuation of L9645. L9662 is probably cut by possible pit L9663. L9662 is reached by cleaning locus L9603. L9662 is just reached at its lower southern edge by the upper northern edge of L9668, which is of the same fallen mudbrick material matrix as L9662. L9662 is cut by pit L9655. L9662 covers a portion of L9679, which is of the same fallen mudbrick material matrix as L9662. The material of L9662 extends beneath the unexcavated below W9015, L9604, and W9510 (below the extension of L9644).

**Additional Observations/Value:** Fallen mudbrick locus cut by Persian pit and covered by foundation trench of large "pier and ashlar" Persian/Hellenistic wall.

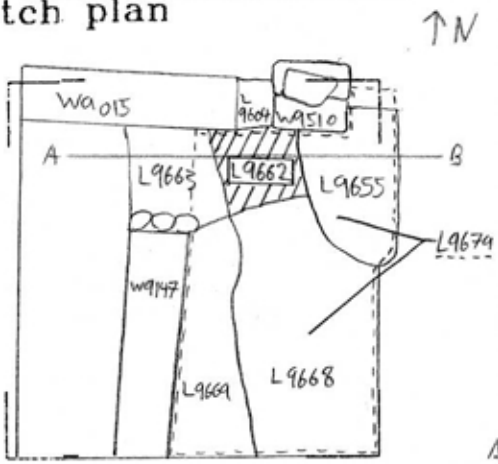

Sketch plan

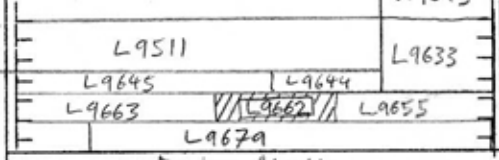
