**Summary**

Opened: Pit excavated to delineate mud brick seen in balk to E. which is a continuation of L9639.

Limits (N) Bounded by L9107, L9183, L9236 and L9261

(S) Bounded by L9260 and L9236

(E) Bounded by L9694 (abandoned fill below) (fill below L9025)

(W) Bounded by L9107, L9182, L9236 and L9261

Closed: when all of pit was removed.

Matrix: Very hard, compact light grey fill unlike L9107, L9183, L9236, L9261. Similar to L9260. Many shreds, shells, hard bone.

Relations: L9664 is probably a continuation of pit L9260. L9664 is probably with L9025 foundation material from L9025. It cuts L9694, the mud-brick debris under the E. section of L9025, and also abuts L9236. L9664 cuts L9261, L9182 and L9183. L9107 is a later fill (Hellenistic or Roman) below the pavement L9095 - this probably cuts L9664. or is reached by it.

Additional Observations/Value: JA. Pers. in pits, sealed below Roman drain L9025

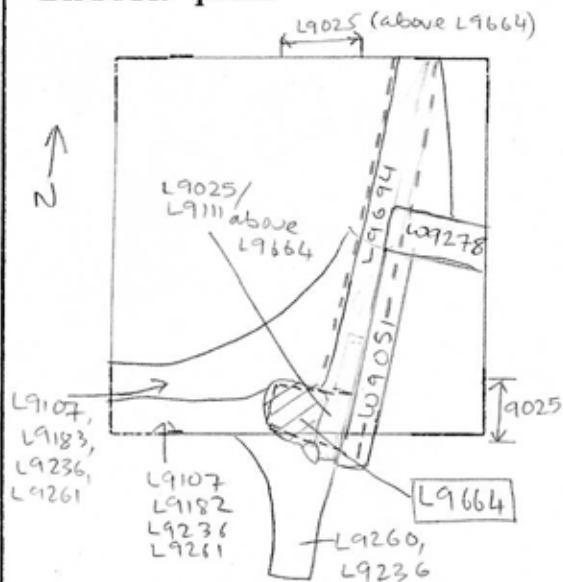
