**Opened:** When the lower southern course of W9636 were revealed while excavating L9654. Material south of W9636 became L9670.

Limits (N) W9636, L9705

(S) Balk

(E) L9671, 19641

(W) Material below L9025

**Closed:** When L9670, L9671, L9705 (south portion)<sup>part of 9672</sup> and L9688 were leveled to the same height and seen to be the same material; collapsed into 19718.

**Matrix:** The fill is heavy mudbrick debris; it is the same throughout the locus; it is similar to all of L9671, the western part of L9672, and to L9653 north of wall W9636, and L9688 below 9653

**Relations:** L9670 is covered by 19654, and it covers L9718. To the north the locus is cut by W9636 as W9636 is foundational at this level. L9670 probably is the same as L9705 below W9636. On the east L9670 seems to be the same material as L9671, which is ultimately sealed by W9047. To the south L9670 seems to extend into the balk. On the west L9670 seems to extend into the area below drain L9025, L9025 floats well above L9670. L9670 is probably collapse of a mudbrick wall.


