Opened: Came down on floor [F9660], opened [L9673] as floor makeup and fill below floor

Limits (N) Bounded by the N bank of AI32

(S) Bounded by [L9165]

(E) Bounded by the E bank of AI32

(W) Bounded by material below [W9051]

Closed: Came down on floor [F9673]; opened [L9678] as floor makeup and fill below

Matrix: Floormakeup² consisted of a thin layer of crushed kurkar, mudbrick debris & bits of charcoal; also a substantial amount of pottery, including two joining pieces of white cyprite, and bones

Relations: [L9673] covers and seals [L9678]. [L9660] covers and seals [L9673]. To the N, [L9673] reaches the material at the bank line between AI32 and AI33, but since AI33 has not yet been excavated here, we cannot yet determine their relation. To the E, [L9673] reaches the material in the 1989 E bank of AI32. In 1989, the E bank of AI32 was cut back .5 m because of heavy erosion, without being excavated stratigraphically, therefore, there are no loci that directly relate to [L9673]. To the W, [W9051] floats above [L9673]. To the S, [L9673] may be identical to [L9165], described as "fill partly above floor." In [L9165], however, the floor was only seen in the southern part of AI32. [L9165] ran across most of the eastern half of AI32, with a matrix of "clayey" and mudbrick material. The elevation of the floor in [L9165] was 14.45, sloping down to 14.36 into square AI31 to the S. To the W, [W9051] floats above [L9673]. It is unclear whether [F9673] continues into the pedestal below [W9051] because of its fragmentary nature and the presence of mudbrick material in the western part of the locus which may interrupt the floor.

Additional Observations/Value: Although fragmentary, [F9673] spread across entire locus and is part of a series of sealed floors.

Sketch plan

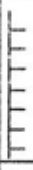
