Opened: A rubble locus 9298 was removed, the wall 9675 was defined.

Limits (N) L9298, A134

(S) W9298

(E) L9298, 1631 and L9646

(W) L9298, 9

Closed: When removed.

Matrix: Several double-head size boulders, head-size cobbles and many half-head size and smaller cobbles

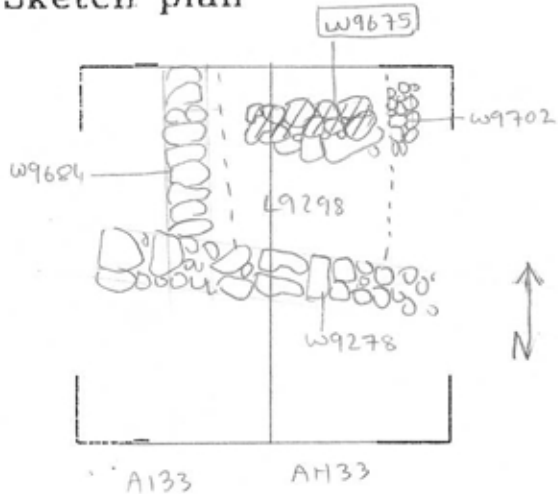
Relations: As L9298 was being taken down it became apparent that some of the wall probably belonged to which it was rubble from. This wall was defined as 3 courses of boulders and large rubble in the center of L9298. W9675 appears to have no relation to W9684 to the west or W9702 and W9266 to the east. W9675 sees the as yet unnumbered loci below it. Since the rubble of 9298 covers 9675 on all sides it is impossible to define 9675's relations to other loci around it

Additional Observations/Value: Not related to any features around it; of little value.
