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Summary

Opened: Came down on floor [L9678]; opened [L9685] as floor makeup and fill below

Limits (N) Bounded by N bank of A132
 (S) Bounded by [L9208]
 (E) Bounded by E bank of A132
 (W) Bounded by material below [W9051]

Closed: Came down on two distinct soils; opened [L9690] to E, and as-of-yet unnamed area to W, W9728

Matrix: Mudbrick debris material, to the W, more crumbly, and with little pottery

Relations: [L9685] covers and seals [L9690]. ** [L9678] covers and seals [L9685]. To the N, [L9685] reaches the material at the bank line between A132 & A133, but since A133 has not yet been excavated here, we cannot yet determine their relation. To the E, [L9685] reaches the material in the 1989 E bank of A132. In 1989, the E bank of A132 was cut back .5 m because of heavy erosion, without being excavated stratigraphically. Therefore, there are no loci that directly relate to [L9685]. To the W, [W9051] floats above [L9685].* To the S, [L9685] may be identical to [L9208], described as a fill of mud-brick material; however, no floor is mentioned in [L9208]. * [L9685] seems to continue into the pedestal below [W9051], where the fill material of [L9685] may be identical with the material of the pedestal at that elevation.

** [L9685] also covers and seals the material to the west of [L9690], an area of mudbrick material that has not yet been assigned a locus number, and which will not be excavated until [W9051] above has been removed & the pedestal below excavated. mudbrick material seems to be a wall with a stone foundation running on a N-S axis. (Note: mudbrick now given locus number, [W9728])

Additional Observations/Value: [L9685] is part of a series of sealed floors and fills.
