Opened: L9693 came down on possible fragmentary floor; L9699 was opened below this.

Limits (N) Rubble debris below W9675 and W9702 and fill below L9637

(S) L9708, L9709 and base of W9278.

(E) W9266

(W) W9684.

Closed: At base of FT for W9278.

Matrix: Hard compact mud-brick debris mixed with many fist-sized and half-head sized cobbles and kurtax fragments. Similar to L9693 above and to mud-brick debris loci to the south (9708, 9709, 9711, 9666, 9665), the east (9638, 9692, 9639, 9642, 9694) and above (9687, 9693, 9674).

Relations: L9693 covers, <sup>but does not seal</sup> L9699. Ongoing through floor in L9693 into L7699, it appears that this was simply the remains of a kurtax rich mud-brick. L9699 reaches W9266 and W9684. L9699 is probably a continuation of L9708 and L9709, two mud-brick debris loci below W9278. L9699 is cut by W9278, a Persian pier and rubble wall. L9699 is probably a continuation of rubble fall below W9675 and W9702 and also a continuation of mud-brick debris below L9637. L9699 continues below as L9722, and also continues west of W9684 as L9694. L9699 does not connect with L9630 or L9657 east of W9266. The material in these loci is of a lighter grey with much less mud-brick debris.

Additional Observations/Value: Unsealed rubble and fill, cut by later wall, Medium to low value.

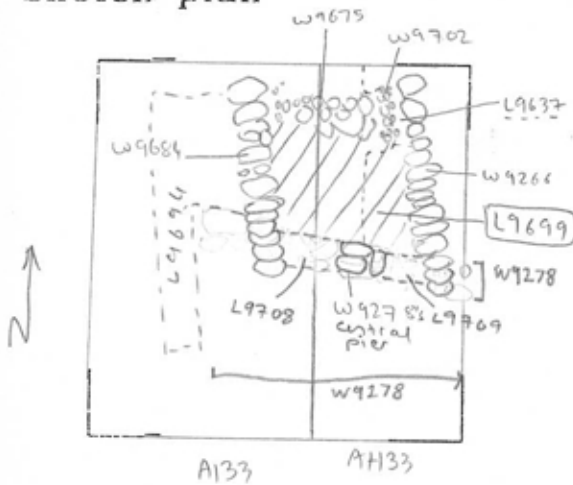
