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Summary

Opened: Opened [19700] after 19697 above came down upon W9282 and there was a NS soil change. 19697 closed and became from N to S: W9282, [19700] (mudbrick) and 19701 (pit-like material)

Limits (N) W9282

(S) 19701

(E) 19311

(W) 19651

Closed: End of Season - Not closed

Matrix: [19700] is pure mudbrick unlike the light, loose soil above in 19697, the medium brown pit-like soil south in 19701, and the dark brown pit soil in 19651. [19700]'s mudbrick is most like soil east in 19251 which was medium brown with mudbrick debris (level = 16.16 - 15.52). [19700] is dissimilar to the deposit it actually reaches, below 19251, 19311 which was sandy brown (level = 15.58 - 14.90).

Relations: Above [19700] was 19697 which was part of the 19697/19149 fill beside drawn 19111 matrix which may have cut [19700]. W9282 cuts [19700] at the north. East, mudbrick [19700] reaches sandy, brown, ashy accumulation¹⁹³¹¹ above. A134's thin, plaster floor 19311. Curiously, [19700] resembles the locus above 19311 which is hard brown mudbrick debris 19249, although the levels indicate that [19700] and 19249 do not reach each other. South, [19700] reaches or could be cut by pit-like material 19701 which may be a continuation of A134's E. pit 19651. (If 19701 is a continuation of pit 19651, then it cuts [19700].) At the west, [19700] is cut by pit 19651. [19700] is fallen mudbrick debris that is cut by several or met by several actions in a disturbed area, which may become more clear as 19681, 19701 and [19700] are excavated (ophorized).

9700 seems to be a pedestal of mudbrick material cut by pit 9651 to W, 9701 to S and W9282 to N. It may continue to East, though this is uncertain.

Additional Observations/Value: Little value: pocket of mudbrick fall.
