**Opened:** Came down on [F9661]; opened [L9703] as floormakeup & fill below

**Limits (N)** Bounded by [W9704]

(S) Bounded by material in S bank of A132 & [L9539]

(E) Bounded by material in E bank of A132

(W) Bounded by [F9559] & [L9539]

**Closed:** Came down on [F9703]; opened [L9727] as floormakeup & fill below

**Matrix:** Floormakeup <sup>off [F9661]</sup> consisted of patches of thick, crushed fill of hard packed mudbrick debris just below surface & little pottery (special find: Cup & saucer fragment), followed by more yellowish & looser soil to S & looser, red-brown mudbrick debris across center, with abundant pottery particularly in center, and lots of ash, charcoal, bones, & tabun fragments

**Relations:** [F9661] covers, but does not seal due to its fragmentary nature, [L9703]. [F9703] covers, but does not seal due to its fragmentary nature, [L9727]. To the N, the fill of [L9703] and [F9703] both reach mudbrick wall [W9704]. To the S, the fill of [L9703] and [F9703] both reach the material in the S bank of A132. To the E, the fill of [L9703] and [F9703] both reach the material in the E bank of A132. To the W, [F9703] appears to be identical to [F9559] described as a "phantom floor" that lay below mudbrick [W9295]. [F9703] and [F9559] are at approximately the same level here. To the S & W, fill of [L9703] & [F9703] are probably cut by pit [L9539] (1989 season).

**1992 Note:** [F9703] may underlie [W9704], just as F9559 underlies [W9295]; likewise for [F9727] below [F9703].

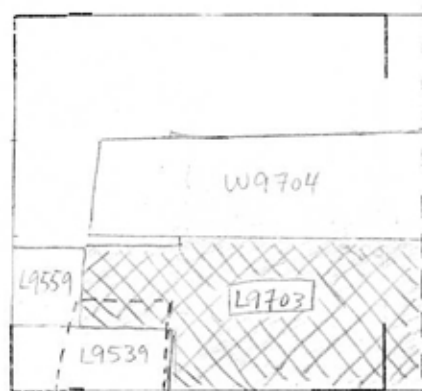
