Matrix: Hard, crumbly surface soil, dark gray in color, with a large concentration of pottery sherds, tesserae, and small rocks (5-10cm). In the C, SW, and W of the square, at the level of the pavement, were a large number of 10-20 cm rubble stones

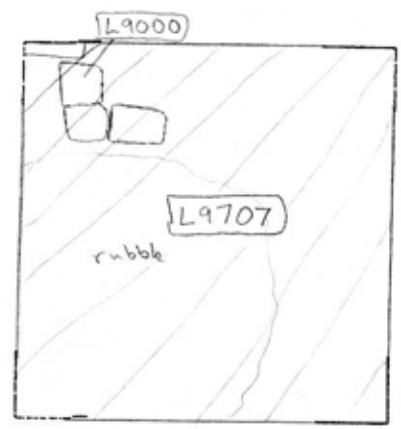
Relations: [L9707] filled the entire square down to the level of the pavement [L9000]. Four large paving stones, which are the continuation of [L9000] in squares AJ31 and AK31 to the north, were found in the NW corner of AJ30.

Additional Observations/Value: Topsoil covering Roman paving stones. No value to speak of.
