Matrix: L9752 IS MODERATELY SOFT BROWN MATERIAL, FAIRLY CLEAN WITH MODERATE DENSITY OF SHERDS. DIFFERS FROM HARDER, STONIER MATERIAL OF L9751 TO EAST (NORTH PART) AND FROM SHERD FILLED PIT MATERIAL OF L9767 TO EAST (SOUTH PART)

Relations: L9752 MAY CONTINUE MATRIX OF L9750 ABOVE. MATERIAL OF L9750 HAD BEEN EXPOSED TO WEATHER SO THIS RELATION IS UNCERTAIN. BELOW, MATRIX OF L9752 CONTINUES INTO L9798 IN MOST OF THE AREA. A PORTION OF ITS AREA IN THE SE, WHICH HAD BEEN CUT BY W9085, BECOMES THE W. END OF PERSIAN PIT L9786 BELOW. ANOTHER PERSIAN PIT L9799, WHICH HAD ALSO BEEN CUT BY W9085 DOWN TO THIS LEVEL, IS BELOW SW CORNER OF L9752. MATRIX OF L9752 GOES INTO BULK TO NORTH AND ALSO TO WEST BENEATH W9774. TO THE SOUTH L9752 IS CUT BY LOWER "B" PHASE OF W9085. TO THE S.E., L9752 IS CUT BY PERSIAN PIT L9767. TO THE EAST, L9752 MAY BE CUT BY PIT/FILL L9751, BUT SEQUENCE OF THESE DEPOSITS IS UNCERTAIN.

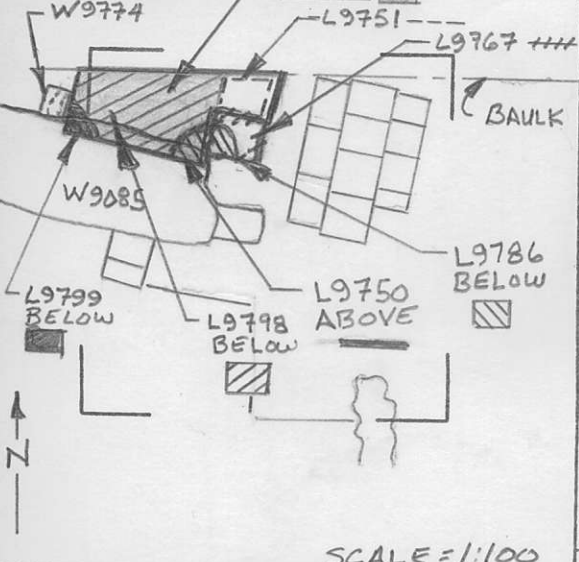
As W9085 narrows downward, more of the Persian pit material it cuts (9767 + 9799) appears, which was not visible higher up.

I BELIEVE THE CENTRAL PORTION OF L9752 TO BE CLEAN, LATE IRON AGE FILL. MOST BASKETS CONTAINED LATER MATERIAL FROM FOUNDATION OF W9085 AND PITS L9767 & L9799

NOTE: COMPLETE "ASSYRIAN" BOWL #97582 CAME FROM THIS LOCUS.

Additional Observations/Value: VALUE OF THIS LOCUS WILL BE DETERMINED BY RELATIONS OF ITS CONTINUATION BELOW TO L9751 AND POSSIBLE RELATIONS WITH FLOORS TO EAST & S.E.

SCALE = 1:100

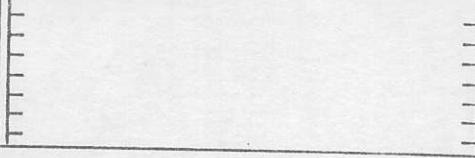
