Opened: Beginning of season - opened below winter wash as continuation below L9694 from last season and L9309 from 1988.

Limits (N) Balk with A134

(S) W9262, W9729

(E) W9275, L9251

(W) W9684

Closed: For technical reason - came down on stone socket to W9275 and changed to L9808 and L9816

Matrix: Hard, compact, dark brown mudbrick debris overlaying rubble of all fist-sized to quadruple fist-sized cobbles in E. half of square. Matrix immediately over rubble is loose, medium brown loam soil with many air pockets. Very little pottery was recovered, though there were large areas of bivalve shell concentrations. Similar to L9722, L9734 and L9759 to the E., and

Relations: also to L9694 and L9309 above, and to L9808 below.

[RELATIONS]: [L9755] is a continuation below to W. L9694 and L9309 above.

[L9755] reaches the W₂ face of W9684, reaches the N₁ face of W9262 and

reaches the E. face of W9275. Whether [L9755] is cut on its NW corner

by the massive pit L9251 is uncertain. Several seasons of winter erosion

have made this relationship difficult to define. [L9755] appears to

continue north into the fill in the balk with A134. The area on

the N. side of this balk is as yet unexcavated. [L9755]

covers the rubble fall L9816, and continues below as L9808.

[L9755] is covered by L9731 in its SE corner, and is also a continuation

below of L9731.

The N. balk is roughly on the line of W9211 in A134 to the W. This may mean that 9755 does not

continue beyond the N. balk.

The upper area of [L9755] appears to be cut by the lowest two courses

of W9729.

Additional Observations/Value: Ir 1/I, 2a mudbrick debris locus - bounded

by W9684, W9275, W9729, W9262.
