Closed: CLOSED L9769 WHEN IT REACHED LEVEL OF SUPPOSED BOTTOM OF L9753.

Matrix: MODERATELY HARD, BROWN, "MUDBRICK COLLAPSE" WITH FAIR NUMBER OF SHERDS, CHARCOAL BITS, LIME PLASTER BITS, SMALL STONES, SHELLS. PROBABLY A CONTINUATION OF L9700 ABOVE AND DISTINCT FROM SOFT, GRAY BROWN, SHERD FILLED L9753.

Relations: L9769 SEEMS TO CONTINUE MATRIX OF L9700 ABOVE ITS WESTERN PORTION WHICH WAS EXCAVATED IN 1991. MATRIX DOES NOT SEEM TO MATCH THAT OF L9311, BUT ELEVATIONS AT THE BEGINNING OF 1992 SEASON INDICATE THAT L9311 WAS NOT EXCAVATED BELOW 15.22 WEST OF W9266. L9769 SURROUNDS L9790 & L9791 WHICH WERE SEALED BY FLAT STONE W9702(N). IF FLOOR L9790 (ELEV. 15.22/15.17) EXTENDED BEYOND ITS SEALING STONE INTO AREA OF L9769, IT HAS BEEN LOST TO WINTER RAINS. MATRIX OF L9791 BELOW FLOOR SEEMS IDENTICAL TO L9769. TO THE NORTH, L9769 REACHES W9282*. TO THE NW, IT IS CUT BY SOFTER MATERIAL L9794. TO THE WEST IT REACHES LARGE BOULDER SW OF W9282, IT CONTINUES INTO BAULK EXTENDING N. FROM W9684, & IT REACHES W9684. TO THE SOUTH, IT IS CUT BY PIT L9753 & CONTINUES INTO BAULK AT ITS FAR EASTERN END. TO THE EAST, THE SOUTHERN 3/4 OF L9769 REACHES W9266. NORTH OF W9266, IT ENDS AT PREVIOUSLY EXCAVATED L9311. ITS RELATION TO THIS LOCUS IS UNCLEAR. Relation to W9282 unclear because no foundation trench is visible in L9769.

* W9282 MAY CUT L9769. I WILL SEPERATE BASKETS ALONG THIS WALL IN THE FUTURE. SEE CARD L9771 & BELOW.

Additional Observations/Value: L9769 SEEMS TO BE FILL DEPOSITED AFTER LOWER PORTIONS OF W9684, W9266, & W9282 HAD GONE OUT OF USE.
