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Summary

Opened: Brought [L9765] down to level of [L9737] to North, with which it was collapsed to form [L9779] since material of [L9765] and [L9737] was identical

- Limits (N)** Bounded by [W9704] and [L9766]
(S) Bounded by bank between AI32 and AI31
(E) Bounded by East bank of AI32 and [L9762] and [W9800]
(W) Bounded by [L9829]

Closed: Brought [L9779] down to level of [L9766] to North, with which it was collapsed to form [L9795]

Matrix: Burnt mudbrick debris, essentially identical to that of [L9765] above; near bottom of locus, came down on large area of charcoal to west of pedestaled rounded stone "structure" ([L9765] at North end of [L9779]); in association with charcoal, the top of two large stones appeared, 40-50 cm, which may be part of a North-South wall below; moderate amount of pottery and bones

Relations: [L9765] and [L9737] cover, but do not seal, [L9779]. [L9779] covers, but does not seal, [L9795]. *The lowest portion of [W9800] is covered, but not sealed, by [L9779]. [W9800] was not recognized as a wall until [L9779] had been excavated. To the North, [L9779] is cut by pit [L9766]. The relation between [W9704] and [L9779] is uncertain. It is likely that [W9704] floats above the destruction debris loci, including [L9779]. In 1991, it was suggested that [F9703] and [F9727] may underlie [W9704]. If so, [F9703] and [F9727] may level surface of the destruction debris, including [L9779]. Until [W9704] is excavated this remains conjecture. To the South, [L9779] continues into the South bank between AI32 and AI31. [L9779] also reaches [W9800]. To the East, [L9779] is cut by [L9762] at the South East corner. [L9779] also continues into the East bank of AI32.

To the West, [L9779] continues into [L9829].

*[L9779] covers but does not seal the Southern end of [W9804]. [W9804] was not recognized as a wall until [L9779] had been excavated. [L9779] covers, but does not seal, the Eastern end of [L9832].

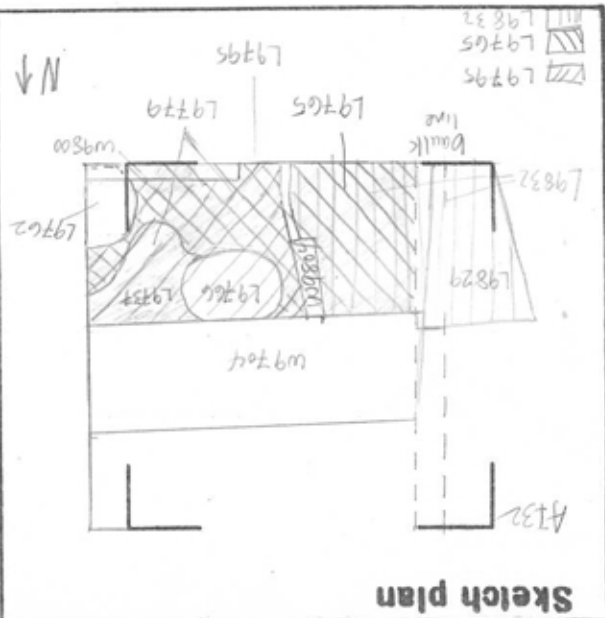
