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Summary

Opened: In excavating [L9795] came down an L-shaped line of mudbricks running from [W9704] to [W9804]. [L9795] also came down on [F9795]; opened [L9805] as mudbrick installation or bin

Closed: End of Season — not closed

Matrix: L-shaped line of mudbricks, ca. 75 cm x 75 cm, preserved at lowest course only; mudbricks ca. 15-20 cm. in width; at West mudbrick line bonded to [W9804], and covered with a plaster facing inside and out; plaster preserved only at South West corner where bricks are bonded to [W9804]; at this juncture, however, a stone rather than a brick is used; 4 bricks are visible, ca. 26 cm. length.

Relations: ca. 12-14 cm. width, with corner brick curved. ^{bottom} Interior of installation may have been lined with small stones, first to double fist sized; large stone, ca. 25 x 35 cm, appears to have fallen into installation to NW

[L9795] covers but does not seal, [L9805]. [L9805] covers and seals the unnamed material below. [L9805] was not recognized as an installation/bin until [L9795] was excavated. The excavation of [L9795] included the removal of material left as a twilight zone to pit [L9766], but material that was clearly destruction debris. Pit [L9766] and pit [L9786] cut [L9805] and must have destroyed a great part of it in their own construction. The rest of [L9805] must have been badly burnt by the fire which destroyed the neighboring material. Therefore, we can only conjecture the configuration and function.

To the North, [L9805] appears to continue into [W9704], but their precise relation cannot be determined until [W9704] is excavated.

To the South, [L9805] appears to be reached by the fill of [L9812], but [F9812] could not be traced as reaching it.

To the East, the fill of [L9795] partly covers and partly reaches [L9805]/[F9795] reaches [L9805]

To the West, [L9805] is bonded to [W9804] to form a "bin".
