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Summary

Opened: Technical change - L9835 became L9844 at base level of socle for W9262 and base of W9841.

Limits (N) Unexcavated area below W9841

(S) Unexcavated area below W9262

(E) W9864

(W) The base of socle for W9275 and fill below.

Closed: Not closed - End of season

Matrix: Loose, medium brown soil. Similar to L9835 above.
Plenty of pottery.

Relations: L9835 completely covers [L9841] and [L9844] is a continuation below L9835. To the N, [L9841] appears to continue into the fill below W9841, and to the S, [L9844] also appears to continue into the fill below W9262. To the E, L9844 reaches the W. face of W9684. To the W, the bottom 4-5cm of the stone socle for W9275 into [L9841]. Below this, [L9844] probably continues into the fill below W9275. No destruction was noted at the base level of this locus even though directly N. below the rubble covering W9841 and at the floor level of this wall (13.42) the top of the 12th century destruction was seen. As yet no satisfactory reason for this discrepancy is known. Note also that in AT32, L9765, the top of the destruction material is at 13.39-13.47 and so [L9844] should have encountered it if the destruction is widespread and the Ir I. town relatively level.

Additional Observations/Value: Ir I fill reaching W9684 - low stratigraphic value?
