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Summary

Opened: Opened to excavate through [F9824] and [L9730] and the eroded area of [L9554].

Limits (N) Stone socket for [W9262]
(S) Mudbrick wall [W9704]
(E) Stone socket for [W9728]
(W) Stone pavement [L9300] and the unexcavated area N. of this

Closed: When we came down on [F9857] and on [W9887] (the mudbrick line/wall), it split into [L9879] N. of [W9887] and [L9878] S. of [W9887].

Matrix: Floor make-up of [F9824] above was destroyed by off-season erosion. Matrix was areas of off-season wash on top of dark grey compact mudbrick with inclusions of burnt wood and charcoal. Floor was highly fragmentary, surviving only in patches. Partial earth floor mixed with crushed tuff and ash. 25cm wide line of gray mudbricks runs E-W in N. area of locus.

Relations: [L9824] covers but does not seal [L9857]. [L9730] covers but does not seal [L9857]. [L9730] may continue into [L9857]. [L9730] was excavated at the end of the 91 season and not fully excavated. Fragments of possible floor were noted in the locus card which may be [F9857]. The eroded remains of [L9554] covers but does not seal [L9857]. [L9857] covers but does not seal [W9887]. To the N. [L9857] is probably cut by [W9262]. If it reaches [W9262] and the floor continued this far N. it would reach approx 15cm below the top of the socket [F9857] doesn't reach [W9887] and does not survive N. of it. To the S. [L9857] reaches the mudbrick wall [W9704] and the floor also clearly reaches the mudbricks themselves. To the W. [L9857] is probably cut by the pavement [L9300]. To the E. [L9857] either reaches or is cut by [W9728]. This relationship is uncertain though patches of floor were found to come within 1cm of the socket and were rising as they approached it suggesting the floor also reached [W9728]. This floor is probably an earlier surface of [F9824] above. [F9857] probably does not relate to the pavement [L9300] which is approximately 15cm above the level of the floor.

Additional Observations/Value: Pure IR1 assemblage in matrix; does not seal loci below; medium value. Additional photos 100766 to 100700.
