L9858 on this card is a "typo"; should be 9856 [cleaning locus]

Closed: WHEN THE WEST HALF OF THE LOCUS UNCOVERED A POSSIBLE WALL/STONE FEATURE.

Matrix: COMPACT MEDIUM BROWN SANDY SILT WITH INCLUSIONS OF MUD-BRICK MATERIAL AND A MODERATE AMOUNT OF BONE AND POTTERY. THE AMOUNT OF MUD BRICK MAKES IT COMPLETELY UN-LIKE L9896 TO THE NORTH. F9897 IS A PARTIAL FLOOR OF CRUSHED KURKAR.

Relations: F9897 IS COVERED BUT NOT SEALED BY L9657 AND CLEANING LOCUS L9858. IT COVERS BUT DOES NOT SEAL W9936, W9990, L9951, AND L9983. MUDBRICK WALL W9989 IS ALSO PARTIALLY COVERED BUT NOT SEALED BY L9897. L9897 CONTINUES INTO THE BULK WITH A633 AND INTO THE FILL BELOW W9096. L9897 ALSO REACHES W9936 A BIT BECAUSE IT TOOK A FEW CM TO DISCOVER THAT THERE WAS A WALL STRUCTURE AND NOT A PILE OF RUBBLE. F9897 IS A PARTIAL FLOOR WHICH REACHES W9989 TO THE NORTH AND W9936 TO THE WEST. ALTHOUGH F9897 AND F9896 ARE SEPARATED BY W9989, THE TWO FLOORS ARE PROBABLY OF THE SAME USE PERIOD BECAUSE THEY HAVE SIMILAR ELEVATIONS IT IS UNCLEAR WHETHER L9897 CUTS OR REACHES L9896 - IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE TWO FLOORS ARE CONTEMPORARY. MUDBRICK WALL W9989 IS ONLY COVERED BY L9897 FOR ABOUT 6 TO 8 CM FROM THE SOUTH. WHEN THIS WAS SCRAPED AWAY, ADDITIONAL MUDBRICK MATERIAL WAS FOUND BELOW.

Additional Observations/Value: MODERATE VALUE - AREA IS UNSEALED. F9897 IS VALUABLE BECAUSE IT REACHES W9983 AND W9936.

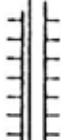
