**Opened:** in previous season (see 1989 card).

**Limits (N)** L9908 and pit L  
**(S)** bank  
**(E)** L9947 L9941 L9920  
**(W)** L9891

**Closed:** when F9947 was uncovered at bottom of pit.

**Matrix:** medium brown sandy soil with a large amount of sherds, animal bone, and marine shell. Also contains a small amount of murex-stained sherds and flint debitage.

**Relations:** [L9900] is a direct continuation of pit L9475 above; they are the same deposit. L9900 came to an end when it came down on F9947; there is no locus below the floor this season.  
 To the N: [L9900] cuts L9908 and L9996 which was only defined in L9908 after L9908 was excavated ca. 40 cm  
 To the E: [L9900] cuts L9920, F9920, L9941 and L9947  
 To the S: [L9900] continues into the bank  
 To the W: [L9900] continues into the bank. It also continues in A132 as L9891.

**Additional Observations/Value:** L9900 is a disturbed locus with little, if any, stratigraphic value; but it did contain purple-murex stained sherds!
