Summary

**Opened:** Pit L9186 came down on W9904, with material East of wall becoming L9905 and material West of wall L99031.

**Limits (N)** Bounded by unexcavated material below W9085 to the North.

**(S)** Bounded by W9211 to the South

**(E)** Bounded by the eastern bank of SQ. AJ34 to the East.

**(W)** Bounded by W9904 to the West.

**Closed:** Not closed, end of season.

**Matrix:** Unclear, not excavated. Probably mudbrick material with many sherds.

**Relations:** L9905 is cut by L9186 above. L9905 reaches and continues into the unexcavated material below W9085 and the eastern bank of SQ. AJ34. L9905 reaches W9904 and W9211. Although L9905 is cut by pit L9186 and should have a value of disturbed, it has been given a value of unsealed because the area of the locus was excavated beyond the low point of pit L9186 as seen in the E. bank of SQ. AJ34 before being given a locus number, thus avoiding any possible contamination.

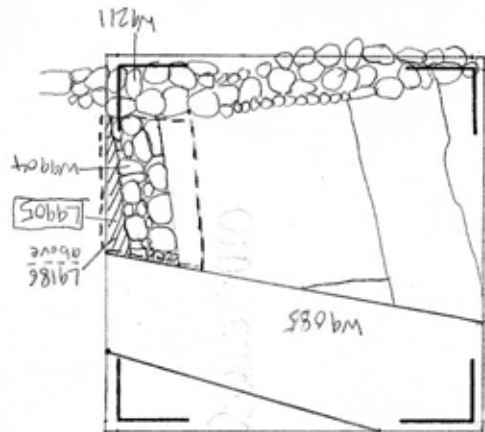
Additional Observations/Value: Small probable Iron Age locus reaching two Iron Age walls of multiple phasings. Unexcavated. Medium Value.
