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Summary

Opened: when walls W9412 and W9413 were removed to excavate fill below.

Limits (N) L9525

(S) bank

(E) L9434 L9494

(W) L9475

Closed: came down on F9920, an extension of F9851/9493.

Matrix: Fill above F9920 is comprised of light to medium brown sandy silt, small amounts of bone and shell fragments, charcoal bits, Kurkar pebbles, and mud brick material. Floor 9920 is comprised of grayish white, compacted ash plaster.\*

Relations: [L9920] is sealed by W9412 to the north, and by W9413 to the east. [L9920] continues to the southern bank of the square, and covers L9941. According to J. Zorn, the part of [L9920] that was not below W9412 and W9413 was below L9474, which was unsealed. [L9920] continues to the N as L9525 and to the E as L9494. It may continue into L9434, but this is uncertain because the floor 9851/9493 was not traced there. On the W it is cut by pit 9475/9900. Its relation to L9474 is not clear. [F9920] continues into L9525 on the N and L9494 on the E where it is called F9493/9851. [F9920] does not continue into L9434 but the reason is unclear. To the W, [F9920] is cut by pit 9475/9900. When the wash that had backfilled L9474 was removed, it was found that [F9920] continued across the bottom of L9474 up to the edge of pit 9475/9900, where it is cut again by the pit.

\* Matrix, cont: [L9920] resembles L9494 (gray/brown ashy soil on ash plaster floor). The matrix of [L9920] also contains elements of L9434 (fine brown soil with a few sherds) and L9525 (light gray ashy soils with sherds). [L9920] is unlike L9474 because the fill material does not contain dark brown soil with burned rubble. The matrix of [L9920] is also unlike L9475 (pit material containing many sherds and bones) because of its different matrix. Additional photos: 101469

Additional Observations/Value: [L9920] is a deposit sealed below 2 walls and its floor seals the material below. It is related to its surrounding deposits.
