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**Summary**

**Opened:** At beginning of season when eroded material was removed, and to renew excavation in pit L9168

**Limits (N)** W9140 W9066 and unexcavated material

**(S)** W9140 W9915 and unexcavated material below L9300 (pavement)

**(E)** W9262 and unexcavated material

**(W)** W9400 pedestal and L9907

**Closed:** when W9262 was exposed at bottom of pit.

**Matrix:** Medium brown, sandy silt with charcoal pieces, cutlar pebble, small amounts of marine shell and animal bone, basalt cobble, mud brick material, and a sloping charcoal lens in NW side of pit.

**Relations:** L9921 is a direct continuation of L9168 above. It covers, but does not seal, W9262, W9140 N, probably W9915 and 3 unnumbered fill loci formed by the intersections of these walls.

To the N: L9921 cuts W9140 N and unexcavated debris E of W9140

To the E: L9921 cuts W9262 and unexcavated debris N and S of W9262.

To the S: L9921 cuts mudbrick W9915 below W9140.

To the W: L9921 cuts L9907 and the unexcavated pedestals below W9400 and W9066

Pit L9921/L9168 cuts the intersection of 3 walls: W9140 N (stone throughout), W9262 (stone throughout at this phase or possibly mudbricks on stone) and W9915 (only mudbrick so far).

**Additional Observations/Value:** Pit L9921 is a disturbed locus with little, if any, stratigraphic value.
