Summary

Opened: Came down on L9914 in L9902 with area East of W9914 split into L9922 - partial floor and mudbrick material to the S., and L9923 - greyish material to N.

- Limits (N)** Bounded by W9211 to the North.
(S) Bounded by L9922 to the South.
(E) Bounded by W9140 to the East.
(W) Bounded by W9914 to the West.

Closed: Came down on orange mudbrick material with Kurkar pebbles, change of locus to L9969.

Matrix: Loose grey material with many sherds and bones, decreasing in frequency with depth, with few isolated chunks of fallen mudbrick occurring towards the bottom of the locus. Different from reddish material of L9922 to S.

Relations: L9923 is covered but not sealed by L9902. The fill of L9923 covers but does not cut L9969, and covers the northernmost portion of L9954, which is the continuation of the grey fill matrix of L9923. L9923 reaches W9211 and W9140. L9923 is cut by W9914. L9923 is reached by L9922 to the South.

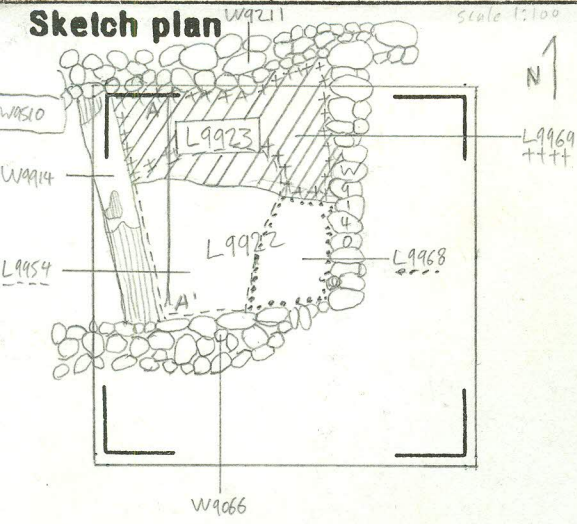
- * F9860 is probably a later and better preserved resurfacing of F9902. Since F9860 covers the entire area of L9922 and L9923 it may also seal them
- ** L9923 also continues into the debris below W9914

Note: a ca 5 cm band of gray material was seen in section immediately below W9914 and W9066 which could not be observed during excavation of L9922 and L9923. This grey band should have been a separate locus. It may have been a floor, or, perhaps more likely, leveling material for F9902.

Additional Observations/Value: Sealed Iron I fill containing many sherds. High value.

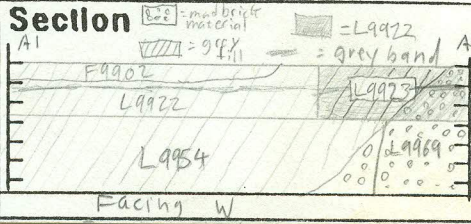
Sketch plan
