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Summary

Opened: When horizontal twilight zone L9859 came down on F9859 to the S., mudbrick material of L9940 to the NE, and fieldstones of possible sump [L9938] to the NW.

Limits (N) Bounded by unexcavated material below W9015, L9604, and W9510 to the N.

(S) Bounded by L9939 to the South.

(E) Bounded by L9940 to the East.

(W) Bounded by unexcavated material below L9663 and W9147 to the West.

Closed: Not closed; end of season.

Matrix: Fieldstones in loose circular configuration. Mudbrick material in center. Further matrix description is not possible since locus was not excavated this season.

Relations: [L9938] is covered by L9859. L9938 ^{and may continue into} reaches the unexcavated material below W9147, L9963, W9015, L9604, and W9510. [L9938] is reached by L9940 but may cut L9940. Further excavation is required to determine this relationship. [L9938] may be reached by F9859 and L9939. [L9938] may ^{reach} to L9975 below W9147, but this relationship requires further excavation to be determined, specifically in L9939. The northeasternmost portion of [L9938] may actually be the continuation of W9211 below W9510, but again, this relationship requires further excavation (in L9940) to be determined.

Additional Observations/Value: Unsealed Iron Age rubble. Possible installation-sump? Medium High Value. (Unexcavated '93 season).
