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Summary

Opened: when F9920 was removed to excavate fill below.

Limits (N) L9689 (= F9493/F9851)
(S) bank
(E) L9869, L9441
(W) L9900

Closed: when floor makeup was removed and when excavation of L9869 revealed W9909 to the N. L9941 combined with material of L9869 to S of W9909 and W of W9440 (old 9434+9444) into L9947

Matrix: Light to medium brown, sandy silt with gray ash and small amounts of marine shell, sherds, charcoal, and bone (fill). Floor make-up includes white to grey, ashy plaster.

Relations: L9941 is covered and sealed by F9920 (below W9412, W9413, + L9474). L9941 covers but does not seal L9947 below.
 To the N: L9941 continues as L9869.
 To the E: L9941 continues as L9869 (sealed part) of 9869 = L9441; unsealed part = L9434.
 To the S: L9941 continues into the bank.
 To the W: L9941 is cut by pit L9900.

L9941 is the same feature as L9869, the floor make up and fill below F9493/F9851. It was excavated separately because L9920 was sealed below W9412 and W9413, and because part of F9920 was found at the bottom of L9474 when winter wash was cleaned out of L9474 this season.

Additional Observations/Value: L9941 is mainly floor make up and a little fill. Few artifacts but does seal 9947 below.
