Summary

Opened: Came down on wall

Limits (N) [L 9993]

(S) bank

(E) [L 9963] and unnumbered fill below

(W) [L 9910]

Closed: End of the season - Not closed

Matrix: Head size fieldstones with a second row of smaller stones underneath. [W 9993] approximately same size of stones. [L 9963] rubble material, stones a bit smaller than stones of [W 9959]. [L 9910] red brown material with traces of mudbrick. [L 9867] red-brown sandy material, only 1 line of stones visible so far.

Relations: [L 9867] covers but does not seal [L 9959]

To the N [W 9959] abuts [W 9993]. [W 9959] forms a corner with [W 9993]

To the S [W 9959] appears to continue into the bank

To the W [W 9959] is reached by the fill material of [L 9910]

To the E [W 9959] was partly covered / reached by the rubble of [L 9963]

The E limit of [W 9959] is not clear. At present it seems to be one course wide, but its E face may be preserved at a lower depth and/or extend into the E bank. Only excavation in the unnumbered debris below [L 9993] between the existing stones of [W 9959] and the E bank can answer this. [W 9959] abuts the E (stone) portion of W 9993.

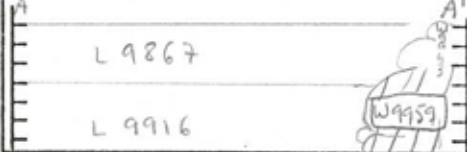
