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**Summary**

**Opened:** L9922 split into grey fill of L9954 in western two-thirds of locus and brown mudbrick material of L9968 in eastern third of locus.

**Limits (N)** Bounded by L9969 to the North.

**(S)** Bounded by <sup>pedestal hole</sup> W9066 to the South.

**(E)** Bounded by W9140 to the East.

**(W)** Bounded by L9954 to the West.

**Closed:** Not closed, end of season.

**Matrix:** Brown mudbrick material with few sherds. This differs slightly from the orange mudbrick material of L9969 and completely from the grey fill of L9954

**Relations:** [L9968] is covered by L9922, and is probably the continuation of the mudbrick material in the eastern third of L9922 prior to the identification of the grey fill in the western two-thirds of L9922 which became L9954. [L9968] appears to reach the fallen mudbrick material of L9969 to the North, which is of a different matrix than [L9968]. [L9968] is reached by the leveling fill of [L9954]. [L9968] reaches W9140 and the unexcavated material below W9066, which is the continuation of the matrix of [L9968] within the limits of the locus.

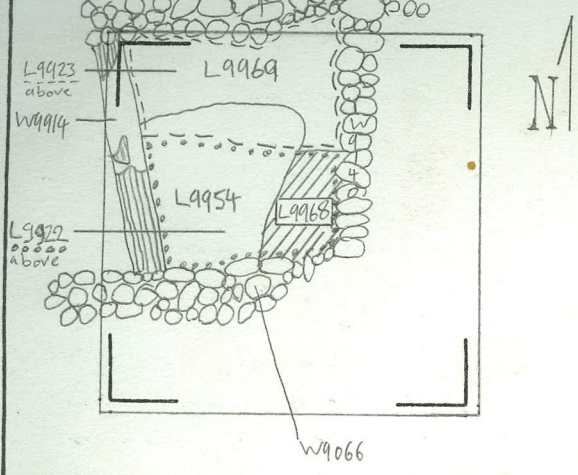
IS 08: collapsed m.b. from walls - phase 9 debris
